February 2020 – The Fifth Money Laundering Directive and Trust Registration Service

- AMPS Responded to the technical consultation on the 18 February 2020
- The Government response was issued on 15 July 2020
- Registered Pension Schemes are exempt from entering their schemes in to the Trust Registration Service
